Almost every object is interactive, featuring many amusing animations and whimsical sounds.

Tiny Airport is now the fifth interactive seek & find activity book in a series of ten iPhone and iPad apps designed specifically for children by the Berlin-based company. The app is available globally in 15 languages for \$ 2.99 from the **Apple App Store**. It’ll also be available on the Google Play Store later this year.
